Requirements for Special Issue

A new requirement for the publication of Conference/Seminar/Congress proceedings (Special Issue) for Malaysian Journal of Chemistry has been set **commencing on February 2025**. They are as follows: -

- 1. The organization committee must appoint a person responsible for compiling the conference papers and provide their name and email address.
- 2. For the special issue, we require a guest chief editor, preferably a Professor from your institution who can work closely with the contact person. Please provide the guest editor's name and email address.
- 3. You can form a panel of reviewers, and each paper should be reviewed by at least two reviewers. The names of all reviewers should be sent to Dr Ngai Koh Sing at nkohsing@yahoo.com.
- 4. All papers must be related to chemistry, be of high quality, and have not been published elsewhere. Referees need to check this.
- 5. The papers should come from various institutions and not be from one institution only.
- 6. We allow a maximum of two papers from the same author and a maximum of 30 papers from the conference.
- 7. After the review process and necessary amendments have been made by the authors, the accepted papers should be proofread for language accuracy.
- 8. The final draft should follow MJChem format, especially for the references, and ensure that all diagrams or charts are clear.
- 9. After all accepted papers have been compiled, please submit them to Dr Ngai Koh Sing at **nkohsing@yahoo.com**.
- 10. Finally, IKM will issue an invoice of **RM4000** for the payment of **20** articles or less. An additional charge of **RM1000** will be applied for 1-10 extra papers.
- 11. The special issues for MJChem will be published in **February**, **June and October**.
