MINUTES OF THE 56th ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING (AGM) HELD ON 18 MARCH 2023 AT 2.10PM AT ONE WORLD HOTEL, BANDAR UTAMA, PETALING JAYA

The meeting was called to order by Datuk ChM Dr Soon Ting Kueh, who on behalf of the Council, welcomed members to the 56th AGM of IKM. A total of 124 members attended the AGM and the attendance list is attached as Appendix A.

1. Presidential Address

- 1.1 The President presented PowerPoint slides describing IKM activities for the term 2022/2023. The year 2022 was described as a successful year due to recovery from the pandemic. IKM managed to organize many programmes.
- 1.2 Events conducted in 2022 –
 - 10th Symposium on Best Practices & Innovations in Laboratory Management (10BPI-Lab) 2021 was held on 24 & 25 March 2022 at KLCC, Kuala Lumpur.
 - Forum on Chemistry & Climate Change was held on 26 March 2022 at KLCC, Kuala Lumpur.
 - IKM 55th AGM & IKM Law Hieng Ding Foundation 1st AGM was held on 26 March 2022 at KLCC, Kuala Lumpur.
 - International Congress on Pure & Applied Chemistry (ICPAC) Kota Kinabalu 2022, Sabah was held from 22-27 November 2022.
 - A total of 25 courses were conducted at IKM Professional Centre.
 - Kuiz Kimia Kebangsaan Malaysia (K3M) 2022 was held on 28 October 2022. A total of 35,922 students throughout Malaysia registered for K3M 2022.
 - A total of 39 participants registered for IKM LMIC Refresher Course 2022. The IKM LMIC Examinations were held from 10-12 September 2022 at Universiti Malaya (KL). A total of 49 candidates registered for the examinations.
 - IKM Laboratory Excellence Awards 2022 was awarded to 68 laboratories.
 - Malam Kimia & Presentation of IKM Awards was held on 2 December 2022 at One World Hotel, Bandar Utama, PJ.
- 1.3 The following events were lined-up for 2023 -

 - 16th Asian Conference on Analytical Sciences (ASIANALYSIS XVI) 2023, 9 – 12 October 2023, Kuala Lumpur Convention Centre, Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia.

- 8th Edition of Malaysia International Scientific Instrument and Laboratory Equipment Exhibition and Conference (LabAsia 2023), 10 – 12 October 2023, Kuala Lumpur Convention Center (KLCC).
- Malam Kimia & Presentation of IKM Awards, 1 December 2023.

1.4 Membership of the Institute increased from 4947 to 5474 for the year 2022.

1.5 IKM will be hosting major events in 2025 & 2026 –

- 51st IUPAC World Polymer Congress (MACRO 2026), 5-9 July 2026, Kuching, Sarawak.

2. Minutes of the 55th AGM held on 26 March 2022

2.1 The draft minutes of the 55th AGM was uploaded at IKM Website and distributed to the members present at 56th AGM.

2.2 The minutes of the 55th AGM were adopted after being proposed and seconded as follows:

3. Matters Arising from the Minutes of the 55th AGM

3.1 Item 4.13: The President informed that IKM would not publish a minimum wage for Chemists in private sector. IKM will consider to discuss with Public Services Department on introducing a special grade / allowance for Chemists in government agencies. The President suggested that Council could propose a reference starting salary for Chemist in the private sector and this will be made known to the industries.

3.2 Item 4.16: ChM Dr Lim Vuanghao enquired about IKM's preparedness towards digital avenue, Fourth Industrial Revolution (4IR) and Artificial Intelligence (AI) in chemistry. The Hon. Secretary informed that IKM organized a Forum on IKM Moving Forward attended mainly by the young chemists who gave valuable inputs. The President informed that 4IR and AI in Chemistry involves invention and innovation and IKM's Committee on Chemistry Invention & Innovation (CCII) will discuss further on this.

3.3 Item 5.14: The President informed that IKM is a professional body for Chemists and only chemistry graduates are eligible for membership application. IKM does organize activities or events involving school students and postgraduates.

4. Annual Report of the Institute for 2022/2023

4.1 IKM Hon. Secretary, ChM Chang Hon Fong, presented the PowerPoint slides of the Annual Report. A copy of the Annual Report was uploaded at IKM Website and distributed to the members present at 56th AGM.

4.2 The report covers the period from the last Annual General Meeting to the Annual General Meeting on 18 March 2023.

4.3 A total of 25 courses were conducted at IKM Professional Centre. A total of 484 participants registered for these courses.

4.4 Four issues of Berita IKM – Chemistry in Malaysia were published. Four issued comprising 79 articles of the Malaysia Journal of Chemistry were published online.

- 4.5 Malam Kimia 2022 was held on 2 December 2022 at One World Hotel, Bandar Utama. IKM Gold Medal was awarded to Prof ChM Ts Dr Taufiq Yap Yun Hin. About 680 guests attended Malam Kimia.
- 4.6 IKM membership stands at 5474 members as at 31 December 2022. There was a nett increase in membership of 527 for the year 2022.
- 4.7 Activities conducted by Divisions and Committees were highlighted by the Hon. Secretary.
- 4.8 IKM has good working relationship with Ministries, Government Agencies, Scientific Organizations and other Professional Bodies as listed in the annual report.
- 4.9 The Hon. Secretary invited members to comment on the annual report for 2022/2023.
- 4.10 ChM Buvearasan a/l Muniandy enquired about IKM's commitment into awareness and reduction of carbon footprint. IKM President informed that Council are well informed regarding carbon footprint and fully supports Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) 2030.
- 4.11 ChM Damien Khoo Yiyuan suggested awards to be given to Chemists who have successfully commercialized products and to reduce the gap between academia and the industry.
- 4.12 Academician ChM Dr Ho Chee Cheong proposed the Annual Report of the Institute for 2022/2023 to be adopted and seconded by DCP(R) Assoc Prof Dato' ChM Dr Yew Chong Hooi.

5. Annual Statement of Accounts of the Institute and the Auditor's Report for 2022

- 5.1 The Hon. Treasurer, ChM Dr Malarvili Ramalingam welcomed members for the 56th AGM.
- 5.2 ChM Dr Malarvili informed that the financial statements have been examined by both internal auditors for IKM, ChM Eric Seah Peng King and ChM Lee Yiu Lay. The report was subsequently submitted to the external auditors and in accordance with Malaysian Private Entities Reporting Standard following the guidelines issued by the Malaysian Institute of Accountants and the International Ethics Standards Board for Accountants' Code of Ethics for Professional Accountants (IESBA Code).
- 5.3 The Hon. Treasurer highlighted the statement of income and accumulated surplus for IKM HQ. Total accumulated surplus for year 2022 was RM13,208,355 compared to RM12,555,820 in year 2021. Total income for year 2022 was RM2,026,081 compared to RM1,555,996 in year 2021. Operation expenses for year 2022 was RM1,237,009. The surplus before taxation for year 2022 was RM789,072 and taxation amounted to RM136,537. The surplus after taxation amounted to RM652,535 in year 2022.
- 5.4 Income from other activities for year 2022 was RM1,009,910 compared to RM674,557 in year 2021. This was due to an increase in the number of events/activities held in 2022.
- 5.5 Other income increased to RM418,211 from RM345,849 in year 2021. This was due to increase in dividend from investment, interest from time deposits, rental and sundry income.
- 5.6 Under Current Assets, the deposits and prepayments amounted to RM136,097 due to completed payments for events that was carried forward to year 2023. Under Current Liabilities, the other payables, deposits and accruals amounted to RM190,429 due to income collected for events/functions in 2022 and carried forward to year 2023 (event/function yet to be completed).

- 5.7 The accumulated surplus carried forward for the Benevolent Fund's was RM785,425 compared to RM747,666 in year 2021.
- 5.8 Surplus after taxation for the Education Fund was RM56,672. The accumulated surplus carried forward was RM696,387 compared to RM639,715 in year 2021.
- 5.9 Taman Sea Property Account rental income increased to RM135,558 from RM109,358 in year 2021. Distribution to participating branches was maintained at RM54,000 as the year before. The fair value loss on this property amounted to RM1,200,000.00 resulting in deficit after taxation amounting to RM1,121,559. This reduced the accumulated surplus carried forward to RM555,322 from RM1,730,881 in year 2021.
- 5.10 The Hon. Treasurer informed that the Consolidated Final Accounts consists of General Fund, Education Fund and Benevolent Fund. The General Fund consists of IKM HQ, Taman SEA Property and IKM Branches' Accounts.
- 5.11 The net income from functions was RM1,064,736 compared to RM763,192 in 2021. Other income was RM551,448 compared to RM448,786 in 2021. Total income increased to RM2,319,714 from RM1,826,368 in year 2021. The deficit for the year was RM314,001 due to the fair value loss on investment property. The accumulated surplus carried forward was RM17,452,805 compared to RM17,766,806 in year 2021.
- 5.12 The Hon. Treasurer presented the branch accounts before ending her presentation by thanking members and invited members to comment on the annual financial statement for 2022.
- 5.13 As there were no further queries or comments, the Financial Statements and the Auditors Report for 2022 were adopted.

8. To appoint qualified auditors and determine their remuneration




